

VERMONT AREA 56 PROCESS FOR REGISTERING ALATEEN GROUPS

In addition to any requirements for Al-Anon members involved in Alateen service Area 56 (VT) requires that any Alateen meeting in Vermont registering with the WSO first register the following with the Vermont Area World Service Committee through the Area 56 Alateen Process Coordinator:

- 1) The Alateen group must be sponsored by at least one existing Al-Anon group.
- 2) Each sponsoring Al-Anon group file an "Al-Anon Group Sponsoring an Alateen Meeting Form."
- 3) The form will be signed by the Group Representative(s) (GR's) or Alternate GR(s) of the sponsor group(s).
- 4) Submit a document annually from and signed by the group's District Representative (DR) or the Alternate District Representative (ADR) stating that:
 - a) She/he has visited the Sponsoring Group as their DR/ADR at least once and established that the group is familiar with the Safety and Behavioral Guidelines established by Area 56.
 - b) Verified, by visiting the Group, that the Alateen group understands the Safety and Behavioral Guidelines established by Area 56 and that the group is following the Guidelines.

If the Alateen Meeting is in a District that has no District Representative the Alateen Coordinator or Alternate Alateen Coordinator will carry this responsibility.

- 5) Submit a copy of "Alateen Registration/Group Records Form" to the Area as well as to the WSO.
